	When Disposing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Put cans, bottles, and PET bottles into 45-liter (or smaller) transparent plastic trash bags separately. Tie the bags tightly. Put cans, bottles, and PET bottles separately at the collection point. When using a bottles collection box, don't use bags and put just enough bottles not to overflow the box. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Separate newspapers, cardboard, and magazines and other recyclable paper and tie up each of them crosswise. Put used cloth into 45-liter (or smaller) transparent plastic trash bags. Put each type of paper trash separately at the collection point. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> General trash should be put into tightly tied 45-liter (or smaller) transparent plastic trash bags. Bulky trash (both smaller and larger) should be taken out without putting it into bags or cardboard boxes. When discarding large quantities of trash, please apply for a special trash collection (See "Trash for special pickup" section). The following items must be separated from other trash. Put a piece of paper indicating its item type and make sure it is easy to see. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Broken glass items, ceramics, lighting fixtures, cutting tools → Write its item type on a piece of paper. Gas cartridges, spray cans, disposable lighters → Write "ガス抜き済み" on a piece of paper. *In case the gas cannot be removed completely, please refer to "Spot collection" section. 					

Trash for special pickup

- Large quantities of trash 240 yen / 10 kg
- Spring mattress 800 yen for each
- To apply for ① or ②, your address, name, phone number, item type, number of items, desired location, and desired date of collection are required.
- Pickup is conducted on weekdays. Phone reservation only (first-come basis).
- Trash collected during cleaning activities by a neighborhood association: Free of charge
- Phone reservation is required in advance.
- As for sediments collected during cleaning ditches, etc., please contact Sewerage Facilities Division (TEL.072-620-1667).

Items subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law

[Details] Televisions, refrigerators and freezers, washing and drying machines, air conditioners (indoor and outdoor units)

[How to discard]

- Bringing directly (recycling fee is charged)
 - Pay the recycling fee at the post office and bring the item to the designated spot.
 - ※ Designated Spot: Osaka Senko Transport Co., Ltd. 1-51-2 Shiocho, Takatsuki City TEL.0120-319640
- Requesting pickup (recycling fee and transportation fee is charged)
 - In case the shop where you bought the new item or the used one is known:
 - Request either of them.
 - In case neither is known:
 - Request the service from an electronics retail store nearby or the city government.

Computers

[Details] Computers, Standard accessories (mouse devices, keyboards, LCD monitors, speakers, cables, etc.) if those are discarded with a PC.

[How to discard]

- Door-to-door pickup → See "Small appliances" section.
- Site collection → See "Small appliances" section.
- Request manufacturers to discard. In case you cannot find any manufacturers to collect your PC, please contact 3R Promotion Association for Computers (TEL.03-5282-7685)

Small appliances

[Details] All home appliances including: Cell phones, printers, scanners, word processors, etc.

[How to discard]

- Door-to-door pickup: ReNet Japan Recycle, inc., which has an agreement with Ibaraki City Government, will visit your house to pick them up. For the details, please call TEL.0570-085-800 or search for [リネットジャパン](#) online.
- Site collection: All appliances that are small enough to be put into the collection boxes (the size of the opening: 35 cm * 20 cm). The collection boxes are installed at the facilities below.
- Discarding as trash: In case it is difficult to use door-to-door pickup service or the collection boxes, you can discard them as trash (except for computers).

Mercurous items

[Details] Fluorescent lamps, batteries, mercury thermometers, and mercury manometers

[How to discard]

- Site collection: The collection boxes are installed at the facilities below.
 - ※ Note: Fluorescent lamps should be placed in the original package, etc. Broken items are not the subject of collection. Batteries must be insulated. (Cover the electrodes with tape or etc.)
- Discarding as trash: In case it is difficult to bring them to the collection spots, you can discard them as trash (except for computers). (Items should be placed in the original package, etc.)

Cremation of animals

Dead bodies of pets or wild animals (Put into boxes or bags)

- Special pickup → Please call Environmental Work Division to apply.
 - Fee - Pets: 3,000 yen Wild animals: Free of charge
 - Pickup is conducted on weekdays (except for Year-end and New Year holidays).
- Bringing directly → Bring them to Environmental Sanitation Center (first-come basis).
 - Fee: Pets (with inurement): 2,500 yen Wild animals: Free of charge
 - Fee - Pets (without inurement): 10,000 yen

Business-related trash

[Details] Trash from any kind of business activities. Trash from contractors' activities (ex. pruning at an individual's house, replacing household goods, etc.) is included in this category.

※ Note: Do not take out business-related trash to the collection spots for household trash no matter its item type or quantity.

[How to discard]

- Bring them to the Environmental Sanitation Center. Reservation is required in advance. Please contact the facility staff of the Environmental Work Division for details.
- Request the contractors licensed by Ibaraki City Government to discard.

- Industrial waste
 - Request the waste disposal companies licensed by Osaka Prefectural Government to discard.

[How] City staff receives them directly.
